<sup>1</sup> The following letter was received from the State Board of Parole Hearings on **October 13, 2015**: “The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) is mandated by court order to have a parole process that allows certain offenders convicted of a “second strike” based on a non-violent offense to be eligible for parole after serving 50% of their term. It is for this reason [inmate A Chiew “John” Saechao] **was referred to the Board of Parole Hearings (Board) from CDCR with a recommendation for release.** The Board reviewed the inmate’s record and **the Board’s decision is to approve.**” This means that the prosecution’s efforts to protect our communities from a man with a proven track record for putting the driving public at risk will be getting out of prison in half the time and will be back amongst us in short order. What do we mean by proven track record? Let’s quickly look at John Saechao’s criminal background: Saechao was convicted of felony DUI causing injury in Contra Costa County in 2002 and sentenced to state prison. He was then convicted of felony gross vehicular manslaughter while intoxicated in Contra Costa County in 2003 and again sentenced to state prison. Saechao was next convicted of felony DUI in Alameda County in 2008 and yet again sentenced to state prison. In 2013, Saechao was convicted of felony DUI in Mendocino County. He admitted the prior 2003 Strike conviction and was yet again sentenced to state prison, this time for four years. However, under the Three Strikes law, it was mandated that Saechao serve 80% of the four years. That
