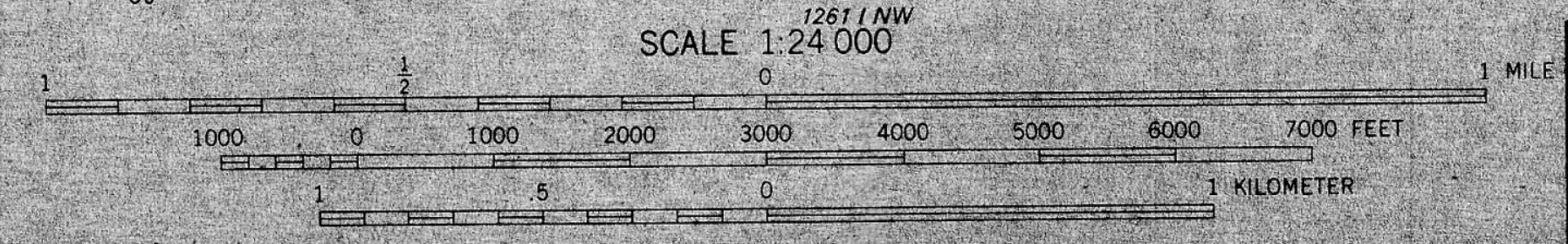
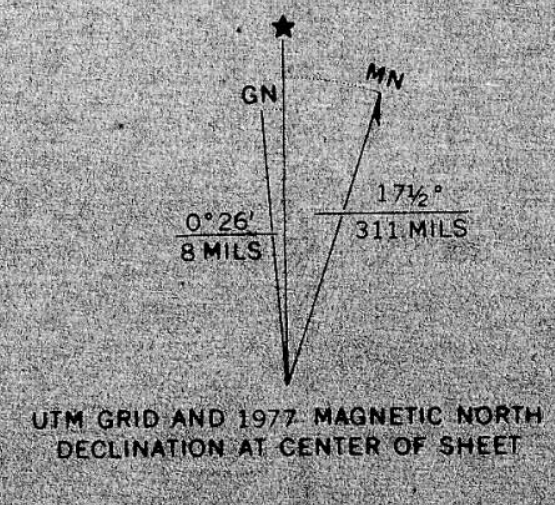


No development within 100 ft. of the upland limit of any stream, wetland, marsh, estuary, or lake is excluded, regardless of whether such coastal waters are depicted on the map or not. Single family residences are not excluded where the building site is greater than 20 percent in slope.
