We are in support of the proposed improvements. However, we would like to see if the review and approval of the proposed repairs includes some sort of safe transition to the street parking on the south side of the building. The elevation difference between street elevation to height of sidewalk is cumbersome and perhaps dangerous for ADA access and use. This is an issue for Ukiah St all the way west to Ford St. at the Post Office intersection with some areas of unimproved walkway causing pedestrians to walk in the roadway to access the Post office. The area in front of our property and the property to east of us is an improved redwood walkway, to the west of us is Kudzu like vines and dirt path.
