(California Penal Code (Pen. Code) Sections (§§) 13020, 13023, and 422.55)

California Pen. Code § 13023 provides the statutory authority for the Attorney General to collect hate crime data from law enforcement agencies. California Pen. Code § 422.55 defines a hate crime as a criminal act committed, in whole or in part, because of one or more of the following actual or perceived characteristics of the victim: Disability, gender, nationality, race/ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, association with a person or group with one or more of these actual or perceived characteristics.
