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**Findings 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 10, 11:**

The Mendocino County Treasurer-Tax Collector has no specific information regarding these findings and therefore is unable to agree or disagree with the referenced findings.

**Finding 3**

The Treasurer-Tax Collector is unable to accurately state how many MMJDs or Collective business licenses have been issued.

**Disagree, as of August 1, 2011, the Mendocino County Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office has issued four (4) business licenses for MMJDs or Collective businesses.**

**Finding 7**

Two dispensaries have recently been established in Mendocino Township. These dispensaries are located within 1000 feet of areas frequented by school-aged children in the town.

**Partially Disagree, the Mendocino County Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office has issued one (1) business license for medicinal marijuana distribution in Mendocino Township and has no specific information regarding a second establishment. The Treasurer-Tax Collector has no specific information regarding proximity of licensed business to school-aged children.**
