Findings # 18:

I agree partially, because the findings include the Mendocino County Jail, which I have no knowledge of the impact on services do to the loss of our County Psychiatrist. In the case of the Juvenile Hall the Mental Health Department worked closely with me to continue to provide more then adequate services. They continued to provide crisis intervention and on going services to our New Beginnings youth with onsite visits. The county psychiatrist's primary function consisting of not more than eight hours monthly was to consult with our medical staff on the medications our detained youths may be taking for their mental health needs. Through a very creative and collaborative process with the mental health staff and Pacific Redwood Medical Group, we were able to continue the medication review process for our detained youth.

Recommendation #9:

We have already forged an agreement with our health care provider, Pacific Redwood Medical Group. We are currently provided with Dr. Rosoff's services for up to eight hours per month to consult with medical staff on detained youths mental health medications. I can assure the Grand Jury we are very fortunate to have this service in place, which can only be done by a psychiatrist. We continue to receive crisis intervention and ongoing counseling support from our mental health department when the need arises.
