

Mendocino CountyWide Net Script

Revised August 1, 2020

QST, QST, QST. This is (your call sign) net control for the Mendocino County Auxiliary Communications Service. This is the MACS Countywide net. My name is (your name) and I am located in (your town).

The purpose of this net is to provide a communications network for amateur radio operators in Mendocino County to prepare for and practice for disaster and emergency communications. This net connects the various local nets in the communities or towns in the county.

This is a directed net. Please do not transmit unless authorized to do so by net control.

Initial roll call will be by local community name. If there has been a local community net in the past week, the net control operator for that community should answer the roll call. If there has not been a local net or if the local net control operator is not available, any amateur operator may check in for that community.

Please answer with your community name and call sign only and give me time to log you in. DO NOT give a further report until acknowledged by net control.

When responding, please wait a little bit after pushing the PTT bar to allow the links in this system to become established before you start to talk. If you have an announcement to make to the net, say so when asked for your report.

Otherwise you will not be asked for traffic.

Suffix beginning with the letters A, B, C, D, or E; Alpha through Echo, come now

Suffix beginning with the letters F, G, H, I, or J; Foxtrot through Juliet, come now

Suffix beginning with the letters K, L, M, N, or O; Kilo through Oscar, come now

Suffix beginning with the letters P, Q, or R; Papa through Romeo, come now

Suffix beginning with the letters S or T; Sierra or Tango, come now

Suffix beginning with the letters U, V, W, X, Y, or Z, Uniform through Zulu, come now

Thank you all for checking in and being prepared for disaster communications. In the event of a perceived emergency or disaster, it is suggested that all amateur operators check in with their local nets first and then check this linked repeater system, particularly every hour on the hour.

This net will meet again next Wednesday at 7:30 PM on this linked repeater system. The net control station next week should be (station) from (town). This is (your call sign) net control. The MACS Countywide net is now closed.
