¹ **Felony filings for September** include the filing of the following violent or serious felonies: first degree murder, spousal abuse with great bodily injury, assault with a deadly weapon, 2nd degree robbery with use of a firearm, kidnapping, battery with serious bodily injury with firearm, criminal threat, 1st degree robbery while armed with a firearm, assault with a firearm, arson, rape. **Reviewed and Approved For Infraction Handling in Court**² is defined as cases in which the District Attorney has exercised his statutory discretion and reduced a misdemeanor allegation of wrongdoing to an infraction charge. An infraction is an allegation of wrongdoing for which only a fine may be imposed. Individuals charged with an infraction are not entitled to the public expense of a Public Defender and are not entitled to a jury determination of guilt.
