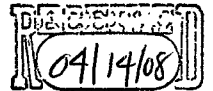

The Penal Code is specific as to the format of responses. The enclosed Response to Grand Jury Report Form should be used.

RESPONSES TO GRAND JURY REPORTS

SUMMARY OF PC 933.05

Penal Code § 933.05 provides for only two (2) acceptable responses with which agencies and/or departments (respondents) may respond with respect to the **findings** of a Grand Jury report :

1. The respondent agrees with the finding.
2. The respondent disagrees wholly or partially with the findings, ***in which case the respondent shall specify the portion of the finding that is disputed and shall include an explanation of the reasons therefore.***

Penal Code § 933.05 provides for only four (4) acceptable responses with which agencies and/or departments (respondents) may respond with in respect to the **recommendations** of the Grand Jury.

1. The recommendation has been implemented, with a summary regarding the implemented action.
2. The recommendation has not yet been implemented, but will be in the future, with a timeframe for implementation.
3. The recommendation requires further analysis, with an explanation and the scope and parameters of an analysis, with a timeframe for the matter to be prepared for discussion by the officer or head of the agency/department being investigated or reviewed, including the governing body of the public agency when applicable. ***This timeframe shall not exceed six (6) months from the date of publication of the Grand Jury Report.***
4. The recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted or is not reasonable, with a detailed explanation therefore.

However, If a finding and/or recommendation of the Grand Jury addresses **budgetary** or **personnel** matters of a county agency/department head and the Board of Supervisors shall respond if requested by the Grand Jury, but the response of the Board of Supervisors shall address only those budgetary or personnel matters over which it has some decision making authority. The response of the elected agency or department head shall address **all** aspects of the findings or recommendations affecting his or her agency/department.

Round Valley High School Principal response to recommendations from the Grand Jury Report dated April 3, 2008:

1. Involving parents and community members in open public forum to foster school/community discussions and engagement in the recovery process is evidenced in our 4:00pm 2nd Wednesday of every month site council meeting conducted at Round Valley High School. Monthly community newsletter and interactive web-site seeking public participation will add to our efforts to involve parents and community members in our daily school activities.(Findings 5-7,9,26,30-35,38,49,64,70-72) Recommendation 1
2. An emergency response planning team has met monthly to finalize an emergency plan. (Findings 44, 45, 49) Recommendation 2
3. Teacher in-service days of August 13, 14, and 15th 2008 will be dedicated to an emergency plan rollout and will calendar for periodic lockdown drills. (Findings 13, 20, 45) Recommendation 3
4. Outside video surveillance cameras will be installed in the fall of 2008 school year. (Findings 7, 13, 31, 32, 33, 46) Recommendation 4
5. College informational planning nights will be offered to all high school parents every 6 weeks by the high school counselor. Every senior class student will meet with the counselor and principal in the first 3 weeks of the 2008 / 2009 school year to review academic transcripts and develop a post-secondary action plan. Parents of all high school students will be informed every 5 weeks of their students progress.(Findings 6, 28, 30, 54-58) Recommendation 6
6. Incentive programs to promote increased school attendance and academic excellence will continue to expand as evidenced by the Positive Behavior Support (PBS) system that will be activated k-12 district wide starting August 18, 2008. The PBS system was planned and developed by all district staff during the 2007/ 2008 school year and facilitated by nationally recognized school behavior expert Dale Myers. The PBS system will significantly increase positive behavior by applying all school rules and activities to three criteria. Is your behavior safe, respectful and responsible?
(Findings 6,7,9,11,25,26,28,30,38,41,42,54,55,57,58) Recommendation 7
7. Raceways to cover all wiring in the Computer lab will be installed before the first day of school August 18, 2008. (Finding 18, 19) Recommendation 11
