**REQUEST:** Consider proposed adoption of an Ordinance Amendment to Mendocino County Code Chapter 6.36 and Chapter 20.243 regarding cannabis facilities.

**PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION:** The Planning Commission, at their March 19, 2021 special meeting, adopted a resolution making a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors that they approve the Project by adopting an ordinance amending Mendocino County Code, Title 20, Division I, to amend Chapter 6.36 and 20.243 of the Mendocino County Code regarding cannabis facilities, with modifications made at the meeting and as specified in their resolution.
