SVP, meaning Sexually Violent Predator, is a defendant who has been convicted of or charged with a sexually violent offense pursuant to Section 6600 of the California W&I Code.

An SVP must be diagnosed with a mental abnormality or personality disorder that makes the person a danger to the health and safety of others if not confined and treated in a secure facility. This status is re-evaluated annually.
