¹ **Felony filings for May** include the filing of the following violent or serious felonies: 1st degree burglary, 2nd degree robbery, arson, criminal threat, assault with force likely to produce GBI, victim/witness intimidation, kidnapping, assault with a deadly weapon, oral copulation with force, foreign object penetration, armed with a firearm in commission of a felony. **Reviewed and Approved For Infraction Handling in Court**² is defined as cases in which the District Attorney has exercised his statutory discretion and reduced a misdemeanor allegation of wrongdoing to an infraction charge. An infraction is an allegation of wrongdoing for which only a fine may be imposed. Individuals charged with an infraction are not entitled to the public expense of a Public Defender and are not entitled to a jury determination of guilt.
