- 10. We have remarkable volunteer Fire Department members. Some of the Leggett community always volunteers at fund rasing events, and the financial support given to the Fire Department is amazing, without it they would not be able to keep their doors open. We would like to see more community support at the fund raisers instead of the same people every time.
- 17. The Fire Department has 4 vehicles, one is a 2006 4 wheel drive Fire Truck
