The MHSSA partners introduced themselves. <i>Grant Purpose – Karen Lovato, BHRS</i> Karen talked about the purpose of MHSSA, the forums, the importance of community participation, and consumer feedback in providing services throughout the County.	
2.	Provider News: Mendocino County Youth Project – Joanna Olson Continuing to provide services in the schools Mendocino County Office of Education – Nanette Barker, Natasha Carter Nanette reported on the Willits Unified trainings at Willits Elementary, Willits Charter School and Three Rivers Charter School for children K-8. The trainings covered stigmatization and stress responses. The participants were enthusiastic and positive about the trainings and resulted in referrals. Natasha reported they are holding 1 MHFA training a month. There are four instructors who are dually trained for adults and youth. Please contact them if anyone wants any MHFA trainings for a school site. Additionally, they are still seeking an Americorps worker.	

	Redwood Community Services – Amanda Pantaleon Amanda introduced herself as the new Clinical Program Manager at RCS. She says they are receiving semi-regular referrals. They are presently troubleshooting ways to handle telehealth and referrals for outlying areas. They are also seeking rehabilitation and therapy specialists. They are struggling with being understaffed, on the coast they have gone from six full-time providers to two part-time. They have responded to all referrals that have come through.
