### 3 **COMMITTEE MATTERS**

#### 3a) **Approval of Minutes from the August 25, 2021 Meeting.**

#### 3c) **Update and Discussion Regarding Measure B Related Items at the Board of Supervisor Meetings.**

- The recommendation to fund a Crisis Respite in the City of Fort Bragg was approved by the Board of Supervisors and will be moving forward.
- NAMI contract: Recruitment for an Executive Director, have received numerous applications and are currently in the review process. NAMI has a meeting scheduled with members of the Native American Communities regarding education, anti-stigma, and best ways to serve their population.
- A grand opening for the CRT facility will be held in the next few weeks, BHRS will put out a notice to notify the board and the community of the grand opening date.

### **3d) Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the Request of Funds for the Crisis Intervention Training to be held on December 1-3, 2021.**

Presenter: Member Allman

- The training is being offered mainly to law enforcement but Member Allman will request to fit 5 additional people without impacting the need for law enforcement. Member Ebyam asked to be considered if there is a space available.
- The board agreed to hold the CIT training at the Behavioral Health Regional Training Center instead of the Ukiah Conference Center. There is enough space to hold 20-25 people and maintain social distancing at the training center.
- Member Miller commented that BHRS has applied for a grant that would award funds to be able to do 3 CIT trainings a year over the next 4 years. Waiting to see if the grant will be awarded to BHRS.

**Committee Action:** Upon motion by Member Angelo seconded by Member Miller it is ORDERED that the Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee provide funds for the Crisis Intervention Training on December 1-3, 2021. The funding will exclude the location rental fee and receipts of all costs will be provided.
