Izen Locatelli states we will most likely have regional partnerships for kids we are not able to offer services to. Our hall would potentially be available, a couple of slots, to like counties. Izen Locatelli believes Sonoma County has entered in to an agreement with the State to be a regional hub for females and possibly sex offender program. The rest are in the Central Valley and Southern California.
