Provider Reports: Mendocino County Office of Education (MCOE) – Natasha Carter /Nanette Barker- Still seeing students and making lots of referrals, meetings with social workers, IEP meetings Redwood Community Services (RCS) – Amanda Pantaleon- Current therapist assigned is on vacation and returns today; things are going very well and pleased with successes; Leggett has reached out and needs to accommodate telehealth for them; communication seems to be going well and is much improved. Nanette noted Tapestry is also on board for working with Leggett. Tapestry Family Services (TFS) – Natalie Shepard/Tony Christensen- Starting to find new ways to utilize MHSSA, good movement happening, services in Laytonville have expanded and grown, now have two staff members up there each working one full day per week. Starting to get a lot of referrals, though there is definitely a		

	waitlist; they are in the process of closing some clients and hope to be able to bring on new clients.

Youth training this Wed, January 12, and Saturday, January 22. Nanette and Kimberley are teaching Adult training for anyone working with youth Thursday, February 10. They also noted access to an online suicide prevention workshop, licensed through the San Diego Office of Education and CDE if anyone is interested in having staff take youth training, mcarter@mcoe.</p> <p>Mind Out Loud Student Rep Program – Middle School & High School (13+ yo) working to raise mental health awareness, end stigma, educate their peers about suicide prevention and advocate for the mental health and wellness of students on their school campus Mind Out Loud.</p>
