4. Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) and Member Matters

4a) Tour of Potential GEO Reentry Services Office Site, Presentation of Potential for GEO Reentry Services to Relocate Offices, Discussion of Impacts to CCP, and Give Direction to Staff as Needed

Executive Committee members toured the facility. Nick Canaday, GEO Reentry, states the lease would be approximately \$4,379.00 a month for the first year. Not including utilities and one-time moving costs. Izen Locatelli, Probation, states this is within the CCP budget. Matthew Kendall, Sheriff, inquires if there will be an increase in services since this is a much larger space. Izen responds that is possible. Jeffrey Aaron, Public Defender, asks what the term of the lease would be. Karen Graff, GEO Reentry, says the property owner is in favor of a 5-year lease, but they are still in discussion as she feels that may be too long. Further discussion held.
