Thank you for your considerable attention to the proposed water tower project and accompanying staff report.

While highly supportive of the historic preservation of the community, I am not convinced with the concept of a faux water tank, as proposed. It would benefit both the property and the community if the tank could be redesigned and utilized to store water, i.e., a rainwater catchment cistern. Private water storage is something the Mendocino City Community Services District is actively encouraging.

A faux water tank that could have been utilized, but isn't, is a missed opportunity and a thing more suitable to a theme park than a living, breathing, sustainable community.
