RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY POLICY COUNCIL ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH/ CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION COUNCIL AUTHORIZING REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODIES OF THE POLICY COUNCIL ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH/ CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION COUNCIL PURSUANT TO THE RALPH M. BROWN ACT

WHEREAS, all meetings of the Mendocino County Policy Council on Children and Youth/ Child Abuse Prevention Council and its legislative bodies are open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Cal. Gov. Code §§ 54950 – 54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and view the legislative bodies conduct their business: and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code section 54953(e), makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom issued a Proclamation of a State of Emergency declaring a state of emergency exists due to the outbreak of respiratory illness due to a novel coronavirus (a disease now known as COVID-19), pursuant to the California Emergency Services Act (Government Code section 8625) and that State of Emergency is still in effect in the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, neither the Governor nor the state Legislature have exercised their respective powers pursuant to Government Code section 8629 to lift the state of emergency either by proclamation or by concurrent resolution the state Legislature; and,

WHEREAS, the California Department of Industrial Relations has issued regulations related to COVID-19 Prevention for employees and places of employment. Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 3205(c)(5)(D) specifically recommends physical (social) distancing as one of the measures to decrease the spread of COVID-19 based on the fact that particles containing the virus can travel more than six feet, especially indoors; and,

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Public Health Officer continues to recommend teleconferencing during public meetings of all legislative bodies to protect the community's health against the spread of COVID-19, based in part on the continued increased safety protection that physical/social distancing provides as one means by which to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission; and

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Policy Council on Children and Youth/ Child Abuse Prevention Council finds that state or local officials have imposed or

recommended measures to promote social distancing based on the Mendocino County Public Health Officer recommendation and the California Department of Industrial Relations' issuance of regulations related to COVID-19 Prevention through Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 3205(c)(5)(D); and,

WHEREAS, as a consequence, the Mendocino County Policy Council on Children and Youth/ Child Abuse Prevention Council does hereby find that current conditions meet the circumstances set for in Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to allow this legislative body to conduct its meetings by teleconferencing without compliance with Government Code section 54953 (b)(3), pursuant to Section 54953(e), and that such legislative body shall comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed by Government Code section 54953(e)(2) to ensure the public can safely participate in and observe local government meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mendocino County Policy Council on Children and Youth/ Child Abuse Prevention Council, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals.

All of the above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. <u>Current Conditions Authorize Teleconference Public Meetings of Legislative Bodies.</u>

The Mendocino County Policy Council on Children and Youth/ Child Abuse Prevention Council finds that State or local officials continue to recommend measures to promote social distancing pursuant to Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to allow legislative bodies to use teleconferencing to hold public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(2) to ensure members of the public have continued access to safely observe and participate in local government meetings.

Section 3. Remote Teleconference Meetings.

The Mendocino County Policy Council on Children and Youth/ Child Abuse Prevention Council is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including, conducting open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(2) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

• Jena Conner provided an update on the status of the planning for Family First Prevention Services Program Comprehensive Prevention Plan.

<u>Discussion of New Legislation Regarding Juvenile Delinquent Behavior, Juvenile Probation's Response and Impact to Services/Programming</u>

- Izen Locatelli provided highlights of the following legislative bills:
 - SB 439 Minimum age of Juvenile Court prosecution
 - SB 823 Closure of State prison system for juveniles
 - AB 901 Changes in truancy programs
 - Prop 57 Provides juvenile court judge the decision whether a juvenile will be prosecuted as an adult
 - SB 1391 Removed the discretion of the prosecutor to seek to have 14 and 15 year olds transferred to adult court
 - AB 403 Reform on Continuum of Care Reform, Short Term Residential Treatment Program and prohibition on placement of youth out of state in congregate care facilities
 - SB 203 Extends Miranda Rights protections to minors 17 years of age and younger

Report Out

- ACES Community Resilience Team Sheryn Hildebrand.
 - Shared 24/7 Help App for Lake and Mendocino Counties supporting website as well as phone app, free and available in all languages. Soft data launch in December 2022, with hard launch on January 2, 2023. Information will be added daily.
- Coast Child Abuse Prevention Council (Advocates Supporting Coast Kids) Jade Aldrich
 - Having quarterly meetings and collaborating with the coast clinics.
