1. Roll Call.

The meeting was called to order 9:02 a.m.

2. Planning Commission Administration.

2a. Election of Officers; Chair and Vice-Chair

Upon motion by Commissioner Nelson seconded by Commissioner Paulin and carried by a voice vote (6-0) IT IS ORDERED that: Commissioner Alison Pernell is nominated Chair, and Commissioner Diana Wiedemann is nominated as Vice Chair.

The Chair and Vice Chair accepted the nomination.

Commissioner Jones gave a brief background regarding her past experience.

Commissioner Paulin gave a brief background regarding her past experience.

2b. Determination of Legal Notice.

The Clerk advised the Commission that all items on the agenda had been properly noticed.

3. Director's Report.

Mr. Gonzalez advised the Commission he was re-appointed Interim Director the 19th of January.

Mr. Gonzalez discussed department reorganization, including the promotion of Julia Acker Krog, to the position of Assistant Director. He announced that Jesse Davis, Senior Planner, and the Cannabis Manager has resigned. Mr. Gonzalez noted that the Cannabis Manager would report directly to the Board of Supervisors. He also announced the Vandy Vanderwater has been appointed as Interim Senior Planner.

Ms. Acker Krog discussed the Phase III Cannabis process with the Planning Commission. She advised the Commission there would be a Special Hearing set for the Cannabis ordinance.

Mr. Gonzalez noted how the Oak Woodlands ordinance would proceed to the Board of Supervisors for discussion and potential direction on March 9, 2021. He also noted the change in the makeup of the Planning Commission, and noted that the 2nd reading of the ordinance would take place on February 23, 2021, which would not become permanent for 30 days. Mr. Gonzalez welcomed the new Commissioners to the Planning Commission, and also discussed his time away as Fire Recovery Director. He stated he would be bringing the revised Safety Element before the Planning Commission in the near future, than it would proceed to the Board of Supervisors. Mr. Gonzalez also explained that he has been working on securing grant funding for other types of projects that would make Planning & Building more resilient. He noted that one of those was a grant from the State to update the Zoning Codes ordinance as well as to implement the UVAP. Mr. Gonzalez stated that there would be special Planning Commission meetings added to address the UVAP and Zoning Code, changes later this year.

Mr. Kiedrowski suggested that since this director's report was lengthy, we should open public comment.

Ms. Aker Krog asked the public in the waiting room if they would raise their hand if they would like to make any comments regarding the director's report.

The request also includes installation of a 30 KW Generac Diesel Generator with a 190 gallon associated fuel storage tank, as well as various equipment and antenna additions to the tower itself.
