¹ **Felony filings for April** include the filing of the following violent or serious felonies: murder, DUI w/injury, discharging firearm in gross negligent manner, assault on peace officer, assault with serious bodily injury, assault with intent to commit rape, 1st degree burglary, criminal threat, continuous sexual abuse of child, assault with a deadly weapon, 1st degree robbery, assault with a firearm on person, oral copulation on child, sexual penetration by foreign object on minor, lewd or lascivious acts with child, **Reviewed and Approved For Infraction Handling in Court**² is defined as cases in which the District Attorney has exercised his statutory discretion and reduced a misdemeanor allegation of wrongdoing to an infraction charge. An infraction is an allegation of wrongdoing for which only a fine may be imposed. Individuals charged with an infraction are not entitled to the public expense of a Public Defender and are not entitled to a jury determination of guilt.
