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- (b) To provide increased benefits (as determined based on actuarial value) not available to the Member.
- (c) To provide benefits to the Nonmember which are required to be paid to another Nonmember under another Order previously entered by a Court of competent jurisdiction and acceptable under the CERL;
- (d) To provide payment to the Nonmember of benefits forfeited by the Member; or
- (e) To change the benefit election of the Member once the Member has retired.

11. Administration and Interpretion

This Order shall be administered and interpreted in conformity with the CERL, PEPRA, and the Regulations, Policies and Resolutions of the MCERA Board, and other applicable law. If the CERL, PEPRA and / or the Regulations, Policies or Resolutions of the MCERA Board are amended in a manner that impacts the benefits provided under this Order, then the Member and Nonmember shall immediately take the steps necessary to amend this Order or comply with any such amendments, changes and / or modifications; or, if permissible under any such change, amendment, or modification to the CERL, PEPRA, and the Regulations, Policies or Resolutions of the MCERA Board, the Executive Director may treat this Order as acceptable. The Member and Nonmember shall be responsible for any of the cost and / or expense associated with such amendment.

12. Disability of Member

The Nonmember is not entitled to file for a disability retirement allowance. If the Member is awarded a disability retirement from MCERA, Member and Nonmember's benefit must not exceed the amount that would otherwise have been paid to the Member alone had the dissolution of marriage not occurred. Nonmember's benefit will not begin earlier than the earliest day that either the Member or Nonmember is eligible

to service retire. Nonmember's benefit is eligible to begin on XX/XX/XX (or Member is currently eligible to retire so Nonmember's benefit may begin) and will be based on the service credit awarded to them. This amount will be deducted from the Member's benefit.

13. Reservation of Jurisdiction

- a. The court shall, in this pending proceeding for dissolution of marriage, expressly reserve jurisdiction over the disposition of the retirement benefits earned by virtue of Member's employment with the County of MENDOCINO [or district]. This court shall reserve jurisdiction to make all necessary and appropriate orders regarding the benefits pursuant to then-existing applicable law. The Member, the Nonmember, the Executive Director, and the Court intend that this Order meet all requirements of a domestic relations order under the CERL, PEPRA, and the Regulations, Policies or Resolutions of the MCERA Board and other laws of the State of California, and the Court shall reserve jurisdiction to modify this Order and to resolve any disputes that may arise among the parties and the Executive Director concerning the benefit payments or any other aspect of this Order. If any portion is rendered invalid or otherwise unenforceable, the Court reserves jurisdiction to make the appropriate adjustment to effectuate the intent of the parties.
- b. Member, Nonmember Former Spouse or MCERA shall have the right to petition this court for exercise of its jurisdiction at any time.
- c. Member shall act as constructive trustee of any benefits assigned to Nonmember Former Spouse under this Order which may be paid to or received by Member. Member, as trustee, shall promptly pay or transmit any such benefits to the Nonmember Former Spouse at the Nonmember Former Spouse's last known address. Nonmember Former Spouse shall act as constructive trustee of any benefits assigned
