



Organic Waste Self-Hauler Requirements for Landscapers

Are you a gardener, landscaper, or contractor who generates organic waste and self-hauls your materials for disposal?

If yes, then these new requirements apply to you.

Organic Waste means leaves, grass, trimmings, branches, stumps, and other plant debris generated when performing work at a home or business.



- ◆ You must separate organic waste from garbage and recycle it.
- ◆ You are not allowed to landfill organic waste.
- ◆ Each time you take organic waste to a facility for recycling, keep a record of the amount of organic waste including delivery receipts and weight tickets and total number of cubic yards or tons transported.
- ◆ If the material is transported to a facility that is incapable of determining the weight of materials received, the Self-Hauler is not required to record the weight of material but shall keep a record of the facilities that received the organic waste.

Why do I need to follow the organics recycling requirements and keep facility records?

1. A new State law (SB 1383) requires counties & cities to monitor and inspect business' records to make sure organic waste is being recycled. Keep your records for five years.
2. Recycling organic waste helps decrease polluting greenhouse gases and slow climate crisis.
