Review and discuss annual CCP Survey, including review and finalization of fiscal year 2022-23 progress and outcome measures, and selection approval of goals, objectives and measures for fiscal year 2023-24 goals, objectives, and outcome measures: direct Probation Department staff to incorporate the agreed upon fiscal year 2023-24 goals, objectives, and outcome measures into the proposed Mendocino County CCP Annual Plan; and direct Probation Department staff submit the completed annual survey to the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) by the December 15, 2023, due date.

Katie Ford, Probation, makes note that Question 19 on Part A will be amended to reflect a 41%-60% answer and the newly changed bylaws will be reflected in the plan before submission. Brief discussion held. David Eyster, District Attorney, motions to approve recommended action with noted edits. Matthew Kendall, MCSO, seconds the motion. Vote taken. Motion passes unanimously.
