

How to apply for a SolarApp+ permit in Mendocino County



Once plans are approved on SolarAPP+ (solarapp.nrel.gov/login to register), the contractor will be directed to our website to create the permit in etrakit:


SolarApp+ for Mendocino County is fully available to all qualified contractors.

Eligible uses for SolarApp+

- Roof Mount on any permitted dwelling unit- residential structures only
- No ballasted systems
- Not located in a County flood zone, check parcel data in etrakit to verify flood impacts
- Located in the unincorporated Mendocino County or City of Ft. Bragg, cannot be located in the City limits of Ukiah or Willits
- Must be a licensed contractor that has previously registered with SolarApp+ permits
- Permit runners may not request SolarApp+ permits
- Fire District Approval is Required prior to permit issuance within Ukiah Valley Fire District,
 Hopland Fire District, Little Lake Fire District and Fort Bragg Rural Fire District.

Submit for an automated plancheck and have the permit issued through etrakit:


- Visit https://solarapp.nrel.gov/login to register or log into your account
- Submit your design to SolarApp+
- A \$25 processing fee will be charged by solarApp+ website


Apply for the Permit

Once you have received approval from SolarApp+ and have the NREL number, click on he Mendocino County website: https://www.mendocinocounty.org/government/planning-building-services or go directly to etrakit for Mendocino County: https://etrakit.mendocinocounty.org/etrakit3/

- Download the building permit application from the Planning and Building website
- Create an etrakit user account or log in
- Click Apply/New permit
- Read the disclaimer and agree to terms
- Select permit type SolarApp Auto Issued Permit
- Enter description, job cost, complete the required questions and enter the SolarApp+ NREL approval number
- Search property address, check box for owner or contractor
- Complete the required questions in etrakit
- If you are within the 4 Fire Districts listed previously, which are Ukiah Valley, Hopland, Little Lake (Willits) or Fort Bragg, you must upload stamped approved plans from that district prior to printing a permit. If we do not receive approved plans from the Fire District, you cannot receive any inspections.
 - To find the Fire District for your property, search the "Property" by address and click on the Land Use tap.
- Attach the SolarApp+ Approval Documents and a Mendocino County Building Permit Application, and site plan for reference, to print a valid permit from etrakit.
- Please note, if you are applying for an Electrical meter upgrade/change or backup battery storage system, there will be additional permit charges prior to completion of any inspections.
- Complete next steps through etrakit payment with Authorize.net
- Print the online SolarApp+ permit for your records

Getting Inspections

- To schedule an inspection, either contact Planning and Building Services directly at 707-234-6650, or log into your etrakit account
- In etrakit click the "Dashboard" and select the appropriate permit number
- Click on the inspection tab, select "schedule"- make sure that the correct day is selected for an
 inspection- Mendocino County only visits certain locations on specific days of the week. Check
 your inspection days under the "Site Information Tab" listed in Inspections. Example: Inspection

Zone 3: 5 days, is eligible for inspections Monday through Friday.
