¹ **Felony filings for September** include the filing of the following violent or serious felonies: assault with a firearm on a firefighter, attempted murder with two strike priors, lewd and lascivious acts with a child, assault by means of force likely to produce great bodily injury while participating in a criminal street gang, second degree burglary with strike and prison priors, battery on emergency personnel, spousal abuse, elder abuse, first degree robbery, assault with a deadly weapon, felon in possession of a firearm, battery on a peace officer, first degree burglary, felon in possession of ammunition, criminal threat, failure to register.

² **“Reports Reviewed and Approved For Infraction Handling in Court”** is defined as cases in which the District Attorney has exercised his statutory discretion and reduced a misdemeanor allegation of wrongdoing to an infraction charge. An infraction is an allegation of wrongdoing for which only a fine may be imposed. Individuals charged with an infraction are not entitled to the public expense of a Public Defender and are not entitled to a jury determination of guilt.
